Water from CFRs is filtered locally, increasing access to safe drink water



## **Community Fish Refuge**

Community fish refuges (CFRs) are bodies of water that protect wild fish during dry periods, and give them a good place to breed, spawn and grow. They help maintain and increase fish numbers in rice fields, and support the livelihoods of many Cambodian people
